## These Items Are REQUIRED for Everyone (Red)

- Seats and Seat Belts Properly Mounted and MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE VEHICLE
- Valid Drivers License/Registration/Insurance
- Working CB Radio
- Tow Points Front & Rear, Grade 8 bolts or Better (no welded hooks or shackles)
- Working Brake Lights and Horn
- Battery Properly Mounted
- Rollover protection (Factory or better)
- Fire Extinguisher (ABC) Securily Mounted and Easily Accessed

## Required for trails rated 3 & 3+ (Yellow)

*All above Plus*

- 31" or larger tires (Max 36" on some trails)
- Full Roll Cage for Open Vehicles and Tied to the windshield frame at a minimum.  
**Older vehicles with rear seats must have roll bar protection for rear seat passengers**
- Winch 8,000 lbs or greater

**Lockers (Recommended)**  
**4 Point Racing Style Harness (Recommended)**

## Required for trails rated 4 , 4+ & 5 (Green)

*All above Plus*

- Front Locker
- Rear Locker
- Full Roll Cage Required for ALL Vehicles, must include down tubes at windshield frame
- 33" MT or larger tires (Max 44")
- 4 Point Racing Style Harness **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED**

- All Drivers must be current on annual membership. Waiver of liability will be required for all vehicle occupants.
- All drivers must have valid drivers license.
- **All trail vehicles must carry liability insurance.**
- Valid proof of insurance is required at check-in. Without proof of insurance you will not be allowed on any trails.
- Seatbelts MUST be worn by all persons in the vehicle when going to and from the trails and when on the trails at all times!
- No open headers. All vehicles must have an exhaust muffler.
- Tires can be no more than 44", based on DOT tire lettering. Not all trails will be open to vehicles with tires over 35".
- No full-size trucks. For example: K5 Blazer and Bronco (78 or later) are considered full size. Bronco IIs are OK
- Absolutely no alcohol while on the trails.
- No pets allowed on the trails.
- Firearms or fireworks are prohibited.
- Each vehicle must have at least one person 18 years of age or older who will be responsible for occupants of the vehicle.
- I understand that Pike County Wheeling 4 a Cause and the Two Rivers Jeep Club cannot be held responsible for any damage that may occur to my person, occupants or vehicle while attending the annual 4x4 Blast.
- I understand that any violation of these rules will result in the termination of both my own participation and my passengers' participation in the Pike County Wheeling 4 a Cause events and the forfeiture of all registration fees.
- I agree to abide by the rules, guidance, and instruction of the Pike County Wheeling 4 a Cause guides and board members
- I agree to abide by the principles of Tread Lightly!, Inc.
